



## SEVERN COMMUNITY HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER

**WHAT:** A 32,000 square-foot, not-for-profit healthcare and community facility, designed by the architectural firm of Perkins & Will (preliminary drawing shown above.)

**WHERE:** Adjacent to the Van Bokkelen Elementary School at 1140 Reece Road, near Fort Meade.

**WHY:** The building is two centers in one: a People's Community Health Center side of the building that will provide affordable, quality medical and dental services so urgently needed by the community. The Community Center side will feature a computer room, full gym, before and after-school child care and study facilities, and a wide variety of recreational, educational, and job-training services that are being planned with input from our many partners and from YOU – the community. The café, community garden, and teaching kitchen space will be a place of learning, fun, conversation, and empowerment.
